- Importantly our comments on the new draft CISPR32 and CISPR35 multimedia standards were largely accepted and we now have been asked to prepare an Annexe for the Standard giving “actual configuration” details for the use of the GTEM. **Martin Wright (BT) (Chairman of CISPR I : EMC of IT, Multimedia and Receivers)** attended the IEC meetings as a UK delegate and has asked to attend our meeting. We look forward to hear his guidance. Our working group hopes to put a proposal to our meeting.
